

# ***Foley Historical Commission***

## ***Meeting Minutes***

5/12/2009

### **I. Call to order**

Chairman Hollis called to order the meeting of the Foley Historical Commission at 1:00 pm on 5/12/2009 in the Council Chambers at City Hall.

### **II. Roll call**

- a) Sherian's School of Dance 113 S. McKenzie St. – Mr. Lewis Newlan noted that the use of pink was appropriate based on the use of the building. Mr. Dave Rauch asked if the Design Guidelines made a variance for logos. Ms. Jessica Nelson stated that it did not, but the Commission has the authority to do so when justifiable. Chairperson Hollis stated that creativity should be allowed. Mr. Jack Purser asked if the signage would be parallel or perpendicular to the building. Ms. Jessica Nelson reported that it would be perpendicular, using the existing sign, but updating the text. Mr. Dave Rauch stated that existing logos should be allowable. Ms. Barbara Wagner made a motion to approve the application for a Certificate of

Appropriateness as submitted by Mr. Cain of Sherian's School of Dance. The motion passed unanimously on a second by Mr. Lewis Newlan.
